RESOLUTION NO. 40-2020

APPROVING THE PRIORITIES FOR WHICH AN EXEMPTION MAY BE GRANTED UNDER THE STATE OF IOWA'S REHABILITATION TAX EXEMPTION PROGRAM

WHEREAS, Iowa Code Section 427.16 allows for a temporary tax exemption for certain increased valuation of historic property, and

WHEREAS, the Board of Supervisors recognizes the benefits of permitting the public to make application for and receive property tax exemption to promote historic property rehabilitation; and

WHEREAS, the Board of Supervisors is required to annually designate real property in the County for a historic property tax exemption.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF SUPERVISORS OF POTTAWATTAMIE COUNTY, IOWA, that

Section 1. The following properties in Pottawattamie County, Iowa, are hereby designated as priority properties for which exemptions may be granted if completed rehabilitation is certified by the State Historic Preservation Office, State Historical Society of Iowa:

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A. Property listed on the National Register of Historic Places and those properties certified as eligible for the National Register of Historic Places by the State Historic Preservation Office, State Historical Society of Iowa.

Section 2. The priority properties as described in Section 1 shall not be eligible for this exemption if they are within and are currently benefitting from a tax increment financing district, a self-supported municipal improvement district, an urban revitalization area, an urban renewal area or an industrial partial tax exemption area.

WHEREAS, the Board of Supervisors, hereafter referred to as "the Board", believes project STBG-SWAP-CO78(201)—FG-78, hereafter referred to as "the project" is in the best interest of Pottawattamie County, Iowa, and the residents thereof. The project is defined as L66 Reconstruction; and

WHEREAS, the Board has sought appropriate professional guidance for the concept and planning for the project and followed the steps as required by the Code of Iowa for notifications, hearings, and bidding/letting; and

WHEREAS, The Board finds this resolution appropriate and necessary to protect, preserve, and improve the rights, privileges, property, peace, safety, health, welfare, comfort, and convenience of Pottawattamie County and its citizens, all as provided for in and permitted by section 331.301 of the Code of Iowa; and

IT IS THEREFORE RESOLVED by Board to accept the bid from Western Engineering Co., Inc. in the amount of \$4,779,738.46 and awards the associated contract to the same;

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that all other resolutions or parts of resolutions in conflict with this resolution are hereby repealed. If any part of this resolution is adjudged invalid or unconstitutional, such adjudication shall not affect the validity of the resolution or action of The Board as a whole or any part thereof not adjudged invalid or unconstitutional. This resolution shall be in full force and effect from and after the date of its approval as provided by law; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED by the Board of Supervisors of Pottawattamie County, Iowa, that after receiving the necessary contract documents, including but not limited to, the contractor's bond and certificate of insurance, John A. Rasmussen, the County Engineer for Pottawattamie County, Iowa, be and is hereby designated, authorized, and empowered on behalf of the Board of Supervisors of said County to execute the contracts in connection with the afore awarded construction project let through the DOT for this county.
