

**CHAPTER 3.90
JAIL LOITERING**

- 3.90.110 TITLE:** This Ordinance shall be known and may be referred to as the “Pottawattamie County, Iowa, Jail Loitering Ordinance”. (*Ordinance #2000-11/November 27, 2000*)
- 3.90.120 PURPOSE:** The purpose of this Chapter is to establish the type of activities, such as but not limited to loitering, message distribution and refusal to leave the Pottawattamie County, Iowa, Jail that are to be considered “loitering”; to establish a penalty for violating said regulations, all to protect and promote the health, safety and general welfare at the Pottawattamie County, Iowa, Jail. (*Ordinance #2000-11/November 27, 2000*)
- 3.90.130 JURISDICTION:** The provisions of this Chapter shall apply to buildings and grounds at the Pottawattamie County, Iowa, Jail, 1400 Big Lake Road, Council Bluffs, Iowa. (*Ordinance #2000-11/November 27, 2000*)
- 3.90.140 LOITERING:** For the purpose of this Chapter, the following shall be deemed loitering:
- .01 Any person who loiters about the Pottawattamie County, Iowa, Jail and/or engages in an unauthorized conversation or communication with or passes any unauthorized message or messages to any inmate of such institution, or fails or refuses to leave the immediate vicinity of the Pottawattamie County, Iowa, Jail when ordered to do so by a peace officer or a correctional officer, commits the offense of loitering about the Pottawattamie County, Iowa, Jail. (*Ordinance #2000-11/November 27, 2000*)
- 3.90.150 VIOLATIONS AND PENALTIES:** The penalty for violating the provisions of this Chapter shall be as set forth in Chapter 1.75. (*Ordinance #2000-11/November 27, 2000*)
