Road Improvement Policy

Pottawattamie County desires to uniformly participate with those residents who seek to improve their road with a “Secondary Road Assessment District” or a “Special Secondary Road Assessment District”. Residents should refer to Iowa Code Section 311 for the definitions and lawful application of these road improvement tools.

The County participates in these improvements at a rate of 10% of the last official vehicle count. For example, if the vehicle count is 230 vehicles per day the County participation would be 23% of the improvement costs. County Participation is limited to 50% as defined in Iowa Code 311. Additionally:

- The improvement shall terminate at a road intersection or dead-end.
- The Board of Supervisors may increase County Participation by 10% for existing commercial use.

Interested parties may contact the Secondary Roads Department for assistance in preparing the Petition and to provide an estimate of the total cost of the assessment. However, final costs are subject to be increased or decreased up until the final hearing.
